Maureen reported on our current recycling as relayed by Dan Doto-regarding Styrofoam cups

A standard paper cup takes more than 20 years to decompose in a landfill environment. This is mostly due to the wax lining on the inside of the cup. The trendy paper cup also takes more energy, raw material and money to make. For example, in comparison to Styrofoam, a paper cup requires 12 times the amount of water, 36 times the amount of electricity and costs double the amount of money to produce.

Further investigation into other ways to "green" the parish will continue.
