



Repentance

Part 1 I Open My Heart

Jesus said, "There will be rejoicing among the angels of God over one sinner who repents" (Luke 15:10). We make choices every day. We can choose to show love for God and for others. Sometimes we make unloving choices called sins. Jesus shows us that God will forgive us when we tell him we are sorry for our sins.

Look at this stained glass image. It recalls Jesus' story about the forgiving father. Read this story from Luke 15:11–32.

All: For we have sinned against you.


Leader: Show us, O Lord, your mercy.

All: And grant us your salvation. (Penitential Rite, Form B)


Reader: "If we acknowledge our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from every wrongdoing." (1 John 1:9)

Receiving God's forgiveness makes us feel:





All: (*Take turns reading aloud responses*.) Make us confident in your love and help us to confess our sins, knowing that you will always forgive us. Amen.









DISCIPLE CHALLENGE Why is this a good story for the Easter season?
