Your parish and/or school is invited to participate in the Christ Is Alive! National Essay Contest. The contest is open to children in grades 3 through 8 who are enrolled in a Catholic school or in a parish religious education program. We will select two winners in each grade from across the United States.

ESSAY TOPIC

Describe a moment when you felt close to God.

For example, it could have been when you were praying, on a retreat, or at Mass. Or it could have been in an answer to one of your prayers, or in the mercy or kindness of someone you know.

God is at work in the world all the time. He is close to his people in their daily lives, in all their joys and sorrows. He comforts us, heals us and helps us. That's the good news: God is with us! For this essay, think of a time when you felt God was with you and write about it.

YOUR FAMILY CAN HELP

This contest provides a wonderful opportunity for families to talk about times when they have experienced God in their lives.

CONTEST RULES

All entries must adhere to guidelines below. Due to high submission volume, we are not able to accept entries that do not comply.

1. The contest is open to students in grades 3 through 8 who are enrolled in a Catholic school or in a parish religious education program.
2. We will select two winners in each grade from across the United States.
3. Each school **may submit one entry per grade**, and each parish program may submit one entry per grade. If a church has both a school and a parish program, it could submit a total of 12 essays: 6 from the school and 6 from the parish program.
4. We encourage schools and parishes to hold contests at each grade level in order to choose the essays that will be submitted.
5. Schools and parishes should create their own internal deadlines for student submissions and allow time for internal judging.
6. Essays are **limited to one side of one 8.5 x 11 piece of paper**. Depending on the age of the student, this could be several paragraphs, or it could be a couple of handwritten sentences.
7. Students should put their names in the top right corner of their paper.
8. **Staple the completed Essay Cover Sheet to each entry** submitted.
9. No student contact information is needed to submit an essay, just name and grade level.
10. Communication Center will notify the parish or school contact person for each winning entry. That person can decide how best to communicate with the winning student.
11. For privacy reasons, Communication Center will not publish the names of the winners. If we receive your permission, we will publish the winning essays and the names of the each student's parish or school.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

1. The expression of faith in Christ and spiritual awareness: believing in, looking for, and seeing God at work in the world and in the lives of oneself and others: 90%.
2. Paragraph structure, grammar and spelling (age-appropriate): 10%.

Entries must be **sent by mail** and postmarked by **March 19, 2021**.
