# **Pilgrims Dinner:**

### Campus:

**Signage:** Per Jean Kelly signage was approved and Mike, the owner, will start the project soon.

**Security:** Cameras have been installed. A sign will be posted noting, video surveillance in use.'

PLC Renovations: These are completed. Pedro noted the 'inside' repairs are underway. Various reasons for the delay were explained such as not obtaining town permits. Some were pulled and others not. The town inspector is on vacation. He will have to approve before 'walls are closed.' When the 'walls are closed,' carpet and paining can be completed. Pedro will check insulation, electricity, fire, etc. He noted that one main heater, in the church, is not working.

**Solar Panel:** A few panels were taken down, per town electrical inspectors, to see the work that was done. The building inspector is next, followed by Eversource.

Jean, as previously noted last month, said the bylaws regarding the process of bringing on new council members were revised. Fr. John and Jack Currant were to discuss the discernment process but, currently, they have not met.
